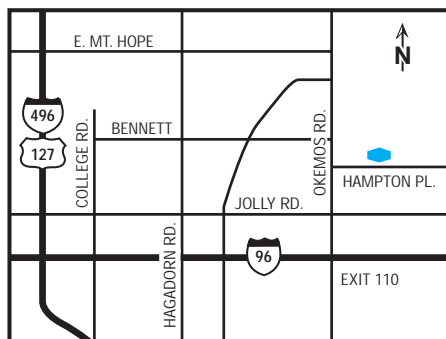

Take I-96 to Exit 110 (Okemos Road) and take Okemos Road north. You will cross Jolly Road and Hampton Place will immediately follow on the right. Take a right onto Hampton Place and the hotel will be in sight. From US-127 (South) - Follow US-127 South, will combine with I-496 South, to I-96 East. Take Exit 110 (Okemos Road) North 1/2 mi. Turn right on Hampton Place and hotel is on the left. From US-127 (North) - take I-96 East to Exit 110 (Okemos Road) North for 1/2 mi.
